Dear Adorabelle/Session I Players and Parents:

Now that the season is underway, we would like to provide you with some reminders that will make each session more enjoyable and productive for your player.

Locker Room Policy for Girls Hockey - At this age, the girls typically need assistance in getting dressed, so an adult (often a father) presence in the locker room is required. We strongly recommend that all players wear a t-shirt and shorts at all times, and if for some reason they need to change out of this, they should go into the shower area to do so.

Locker Room Assignments - Be sure to check the monitor each week for locker room assignments and have your player dress in the locker room. Please do not dress your player in the hallway as it causes unnecessary congestion and increases the risk of injuries. Once your player is dressed and ready to go, she can stand in the hallway until it is time to go on the ice.

Names on Helmets - Please make sure that your player's first name is marked clearly on a piece of tape on the front of her helmet. This is essential for the coaches to get to know their names and also communicate with them more clearly on the ice.

Schedule - Your player will skate at her regularly scheduled time on the following Saturdays: October 7, 14, 21, 28; November 4, 11, 18; and December 2, 9, 16 and 23. There is no skate on Thanksgiving weekend and the skate on Saturday, December 23rd will be a family open skate and holiday party. After the holiday break, Session II begins on Saturday, January 6th and runs through late March. If you are not currently registered for Session II but would like to continue in the program, stop by the SIFH office or call 248-888-1400 to register. There is a \$25 discount for players that register for both sessions.

Payment - Your final Session I dues payment of \$100 is due by October 14th. Payment can be dropped off or mailed to the SIFH office or paid via phone or fax (with a major credit card) to the SIFH office. Please remit the enclosed payment coupon if paying by mail or in person.

Pictures - Will be taken on Saturday, October 21st (on the ice) during the session. After all individual and group photos are taken, the players will utilize the remaining time for practice on the available ice. A picture package is included with the program and the package is as follows:

- Memory Mate – 5 X 7 Team & 3 X 5 Individual on a 8 X 10 sheet
- Photo Magnet
- 8 X 10 Individual

A picture order envelope from Stewart Photography will be distributed prior to pictures. If you wish to purchase additional pictures, the prices and packages available are listed on the envelope. Pictures should be delivered by the end of November.
